



Josephine (Multari) Lamberto

January 1, 1925 - June 20, 2009

Mrs. Josephine (Multari) Lamberto, age 84, of New Hartford, went home to be with the Lord and joined her beloved husband, Vinny, on Saturday, June 20, 2009. At the time of her passing, she was comforted by the love and support of her family.

Born in Brooklyn, NY on January 1, 1925, Josephine was the daughter of the late Ralph and Ada (Fragomemi) Multari. She was raised and educated in Brooklyn, where she was married to Dr. Vincent S. Lamberto on June 28, 1947. They were truly devoted to each other and dedicated to family life during their 48 years of marriage until his passing on April 2, 1995.

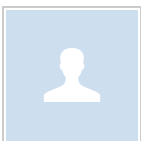
