NEW HARTFORD – With grieving hearts, we mourn the loss of our beloved mother and grandmother, Josephine (Limbrici) DiMare, who passed away on Thursday, July 24, 2025, at the age of 95.

Born on May 7, 1930, Josephine grew up in Utica, NY and attended Wetmore Elementary School and was a 1948 graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. In her earlier years, she was employed as a secretary at the G.E. French Rd. location. Later, Josephine assisted in the operation of her husband's business. For 45 years she was the first contact for customers calling Sam DiMare's Refrigeration and Appliance Service.

On October 26, 1957, Josephine and Salvatore were married at St. Anthony of Padua Church in Utica, NY. Devoted and together, their love supported each other for 65 years until his passing in 2023.
