Mrs. Julia T. (Barile) Piccione, age 87, passed away on Monday, February 2, 2015 at the Albany Medical Center with her loving family by her side.

Born in Utica on August 1, 1927, Julia was the daughter of the late Serafino and Mary (Pacciarelli) Barile. Raised and educated locally, she was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. On November 5, 1949 she married her sweetheart, Jerry F. Piccione, Jr., and remained his sweetheart for 65 years. Their journey was made even more beloved by the blessing of their children. Before starting her family Julia worked at Woolworth's. After her children had grown, she worked at various locations specializing in retail. She supported her loved ones through their life's journey, offering her gentle guidance and advice. In her spare time, she enjoyed gardening, sewing, and was an avid reader. Julia was a communicant of Our Lady of the Rosary Church.
