UTICA - Mrs. Justin E. Owen-Dyer, age 72, passed away on Friday, October 11, 2019 in the comfort of her home with her loving family by her side following a courageous battle with cancer.

Raised and educated in Trinidad and Tobago, she furthered her studies at technical schools, and in 1989 she relocated to the United States and eventually settled in Utica where she has since resided. For over 20 years, Justin was employed by Hospice & Palliative Care, Inc. as a Home Health Aide, a position she loved and was well-suited for because she was an “angel” to her patients, from what was shared by families she served. Justin had a loving heart. She was empathetic, caring, and selfless in her devotion to the needs of her loved ones and anyone with whom she ever came in contact. She always made sure that her children followed the right path and made the most of themselves. She loved to bake, especially her delectable sponge cake, among other confections.
