



Katherine "Rosemary" (Pacilio) Smith

Mrs. Katherine "Rosemary" (Pacilio) Smith, age 82, of Whitesboro, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, December 27, 2006, at her home. Born in Utica on April 25, 1924, Katherine was the daughter of the late Dominick and Catherine M. (Falatico) Pacilio. She was raised and educated locally. On July 11, 1970, she married William T. Smith, with whom she shared 34 years prior to his passing on September 17, 2004.

Katherine's working life spanned 28 years at Griffiss Air Force Base where she was a production controller, retiring in 1976. She was a member of the National Association of Retired Federal Employees, and a parishioner of St. Paul's Church in Whitesboro.
