UTICA - Mrs. Kathleen A. "Kay" (LoConti) DiGiorgio, age 82, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, April 29, 2018 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center due to an aortic occurrence while simultaneously beating cancer.

Born to the late Michael and Angeline (Zammiello) LoConti, Kathleen was a lifelong Utica resident educated in local schools. On May 7, 1955 she married Peter J. DiGiorgio with whom she shared 63 years. Kay's determination and meticulous nature charted the course for her career outside the home as a bookkeeper, and ultimately as the owner of her own tax preparation service. Quiet and modest, Kay will be remembered for being a dedicated daughter, wife, mother, sister, grandmother, and friend. Her enjoyment in life came simply from her family. She practiced her Catholic faith as a parishioner of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.

Kay leaves her husband and soul mate, Pete; her daughter, Denise DiGiorgio; her son and daughter-in-law, Peter J.
