Mr. Kevin J. Fenton, age 55, of Utica, passed away on Tuesday, May 15, 2007 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with his loving family by his side. Born in Utica on June 26, 1951, Kevin was the son of the late Cletus J. Jr. and Lois (Peterson) Fenton. He was raised in Deerfield and educated in Whitesboro Schools. At one time, he was married to the former Paula Schuff. The loving relationship shared with their children has been the common bond for each of them throughout their lives.

Mr. Fenton worked as a dispatcher at Niagara Mohawk Power Corp., retiring in 1999 after 29 years of loyal service. In his spare time, Kevin enjoyed 'tinkering' with automobiles and was an avid auto enthusiast. He also took great pleasure in spending time with his beloved grandchildren, supporting them with pride at their many athletic events.
