Another of her favorite pastimes was cooking, and she earned fame for her baked chicken. She also made wonderful memories serving up delicious meats using techniques she learned from her mother.

She had faith, and often reminded her children "God loves you," as well as reminding herself on so many occasions.

Kimberly is survived by her mother, Regina; her children, Kelly Bennett and her husband Elliot "Macho" Correa, Vanessa Bennett and Zachary Conte, and Julian Guarascio; her adored grandchildren, Elliot Jr., and Camilla; Julius, Ariela, and Christian.
