He enjoyed the time he spent playing soccer with family and friends from his community. He even played on local teams from Utica to Albany. When Koudi wasn’t on the field, he could be found playing video games.

Family was the biggest priority in Koudi's heart, coming before all else. They will dearly miss his presence but are comforted in knowing that he is home with his loving God.

Koudi is survived by his devoted mother, Haga; cherished siblings, Youma Bashir, Lina Bashir, Bashir Bashir, Sharif Bashir, and Toti Bashir; many aunts and uncles, with a special mention of his uncles, Khalid Zagrin, and Nasir Zagrin along with his wife Fairuz Koko; beloved maternal grandfather, and paternal grandmother, who will hold his memory in their hearts; and close family friend, Isaac Padiet, who guided the family through their transition to America.
