



## Mr. Laurie "Bubb" Brown

December 28, 1955 - October 24, 2025

UTICA – Mr. Laurie “Bubb” Brown, age 69, went home to the Lord and was reunited with family who went before him on Friday, October 24, 2025. At the time of his passing, he was encircled by his cherished family.

Born in Hollywood, FL, on December 28, 1955, Laurie was the son of the late Ernest Lee and Bertenia (Chandler) Brown. At the age of 12, he relocated to Utica along with his father and four siblings, joined by his paternal grandmother, who lovingly helped raise them and the generations that followed. She was an inspiring and captivating woman who created a tight-knit family for which all remain forever grateful. Laurie attended Utica public schools and was a proud graduate of Utica Free Academy, Class of 1973.

Bub was blessed with four children and was known as a responsible man full of wisdom, which he lovingly passed on to them. He was most proud to be the first African American man employed as an engineer at Mid-State Correctional Facility—a position he had aspired to from his very first day on the job. He proudly served the facility for 37 years. Timely, dependable, and grounded in integrity, Bub’s work ethic was impeccable, and his core principles always aligned with his professional responsibilities. An energized man who lived by the saying, “If you’re on time, you’re late,” Bub’s remarkable career, which often included working a second job in environmental services, was a true testament to the man he was.

A gracious leader and role model, Bub carried himself with dignity and humility, yet he always balanced these virtues with his unique sense of humor. Empowering and insightful, he never depended on vices and was always available to help others at a moment's notice. His presence radiated strength and kindness, and he was known for his willingness to help others while never allowing himself to be taken advantage of.

Bub was a thoughtful and deliberate man who often reminded those around him to “always have a plan, and a backup plan.” The foundation and pillar of his family, he was the one they looked to for guidance. Rarely shaken, his words were heard with great respect, and his sharp perception and calm demeanor always prevailed. His sound judgment was rooted in his deep faith in the Lord. Grounded and humble, he led a life of quiet strength and unwavering integrity.

A master outdoorsman, Laurie devoted much of his free time to hunting and fishing. He was an expert hunter of both big and small game—deer and pheasant alike—and a skilled bass fisherman. Known as a “Bassmaster” of his time, he could fillet a fish with unmatched precision.

In his younger years, Bub shined on the basketball court. Ambidextrous and agile, his unpredictable moves made him a standout player—you never knew where he was going to come from! His talent even drew the attention of professional basketball recruiters. He loved playing in city parks and representing UFA, and he also enjoyed roller skating, which he considered one of his personal accomplishments. Later in life, Bub became an accomplished and adventurous traveler, navigating with a paper map on the hood of his car, the “original GPS.”

He found great joy in witnessing his children's successes, seeing a part of

himself carried forward in each of them. His family was truly his greatest blessing. He loved his grandchildren deeply and found immense fulfillment in watching them grow. Bub was the organizer and definite overseer of family gatherings, always ensuring every event ran smoothly, whether through financial assistance or his thoughtful guidance. He shared a special bond with his late sister, Glynnis, with whom he coordinated these family celebrations. His playful spirit, love of laughter, and steady leadership made him the heart of every gathering.

Spiritually, Laurie was open to receiving the Word of the Lord and encouraged his children to know Him as well. His faith was instrumental in guiding him toward an ascetic lifestyle, renouncing and refraining from the vices of this world. Known for his thoughtful sayings, he was a true “quotationist aficionado,” his wisdom flowing effortlessly through conversation. Among his favorite expressions were “It pays the cost to be the boss” and “Follow the blueprint.”

Laurie is survived by his beloved children, Clifton D. Brown and Amanda Hock, Tennille R. Brown, Jennifer M. Brown, and Ricky Brown; cherished grandchildren, Shealyn Brown, Clifton D. Brown Jr.; Kareem Jones, L'oreal Hawkins, and Sharie Hawkins; Diamonique Brown, Myah Powell, and Anthony Powell, Jr.; Rahlin Brown, Arieann Brown, and Aliyh Brown; brothers and sisters-in-law, Pastors Gregory and Cornelia Brown, Sherman and Sonya Brown, Ernest Brown (and his late wife, Nell), David and Denise Brown, and Frederick and Linda Brown. Bub is now reunited with and being embraced by his sister, Glynnis Pebbles (Brown) Reed, who passed away on March 27, 2024. He also leaves behind Glynnis' husband and his brother-in-law, Michael Reed; and a host of beloved nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, aunts, uncles, and cousins. Laurie shared a close and rewarding friendship with the late Andrew “Bunky” Jackson; together, they bonded through their

shared love of the outdoors.

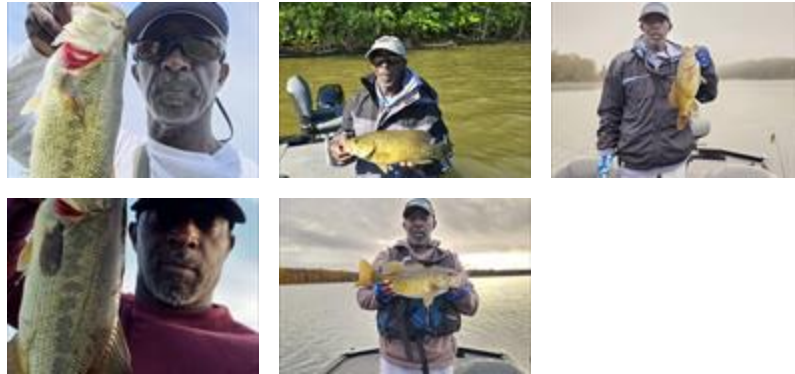
