



Mr. Lawrence A. "Larry" Obernesser

June 5, 1933 - October 21, 2016

Mr. Lawrence A. "Larry" Obernesser, age 83, passed away on Friday, October 21, 2016, at the Masonic Care Community of NY with his loving family by his side.

Born in Utica on June 5, 1933, Larry was the son of the late George and Mary (Adrean) Obernesser. He attended St. Agnes Grammar School and was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1951. Upon his graduation, he entered the Machinist Apprentice Program with The General Electric Company in Syracuse, NY. On November 27, 1954, he married his high school sweetheart, Angela (Paolozzi). The vows they exchanged were honored and upheld from the day of their nuptials to the day of Larry's passing. They found much joy in their 62 years of marriage.

Larry was a loyal company man who loved his work as a machinist and sample maker for the Radio/Receiver plant at the General Electric Company's Broad & Bleecker Street locations. He enjoyed a productive career that allowed him to provide for his family and served him well until his retirement in 1988.

Larry was a humble person, intelligent but not boastful. He was well versed and highly articulate in the history of the Utica area. He amassed many treasures, and he knew just where each one was, and if anyone borrowed one! As a father, he was a supportive but quiet man who stood by his convictions and set a good example for his children. He was happiest when family was together. He loved his children, grandchildren, and great-

grandchildren and as the generations increased, so did his love and longing to be a part of their lives. You could count on Larry to be at any of their events at any time of the year, and he would travel to any destination to be present for the occasion. His family meant the world to him, and he was proud of each of them for their victories and accomplishments.

Larry enjoyed two sports. He bowled for many years with the Catholic Men's League as well as for the Senior League at the Pin-O-Rama Lanes. He also golfed with his coworkers in the General Electric League and recently with the senior league at the Mohawk Valley Country Club. In his retirement years, he volunteered at the Mid York Library where he repaired tape recorders, radios, and audio equipment for the visually impaired. Monday's were reserved to spend with his son-in-law, Joe, as he worked with him at Joseph A. Rocco Livestock. He devoted years to being a member of St. Agnes Parish where he volunteered at the weekly bingo game and the annual parish festival, responsibilities that he took very seriously. He held a great closeness and regard for his pastor, the late Monsignor Francis J. Willenburg. Larry joined the congregation of the St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church as the parishes merged.

Larry is survived by his devoted wife, Angela; their children, Virginia "Ginger" Shepardson and Charlie Morat, Janice and Joseph Rocco, Elaine and Michael Longo, Deborah and Darel Taylor, Celeste and Christopher Karski, John Obernesser, Anthony and Dorothy Obernesser, and Theresa Rojek and Jeff Brown. 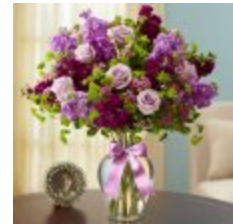
