Mr. Leroy B. Jackson, age 59, of Utica, passed away on Saturday, March 12, 2016 at the St. Luke's Home following a courageous battle with cancer. Born in Utica on September 8, 1956, Leroy was the son of Elnora Jackson and the late Leroy Jackson. He was also blessed with the love and guidance of his step-father, Chester Ivory. Raised and educated in Utica, he was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. He later furthered his education by attending M.V.C.C. A proud veteran, Leroy honorably served his country in the United States Navy. At one time, Leroy shared in a relationship with Angelina Cooper; from that relationship came the blessing of a son. Leroy worked for the Cosmopolitan Center in the Maintenance Department for many years. He was lastly employed with Walmart in both Utica and Florida. 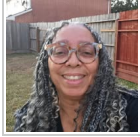

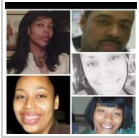
