UTICA – Mrs. Linda A. (Ryan) Denato, age 74, passed away peacefully on Monday, January 19, 2026.

Born in Utica on April 20, 1951, Linda was the daughter of the late James Edward Jr. and Ann Marie (Gottuso) Ryan. She was a proud graduate of T. R. Proctor High School, Class of 1968. She then furthered her studies at MVCC, where she received a medical assistant certification.

It was in high school on Flag Day, June 14, 1968, that she met the love of her life, Louis D. Denato, at a friend's house, followed by a CYO dance at St. Agnes Church. Her smile locked the deal and the two were united in holy matrimony on May 9, 1970 - they shared a loving and devoted union for 55 years, creating beautiful family memories. Their family was built on a strong foundation and continued until Linda's last day. She provided unwavering support to her husband and children.

Professionally, Linda wore many hats and held a variety of jobs while simultaneously having her four children over the span of 16 years from 1970-1986.

After high school, she briefly worked at Dodge Graphic Press as a receptionist and later joined the advertising department at the Observer-Dispatch.

Following that she worked at Dr. Albert Altongy's dental office, served as a

nursing assistant at Eastern Star Nursing Home, and worked at St. Elizabeth Hospital's medical records department. Later, she found her passion providing private home care and housekeeping services to the elderly. She loved caring for her clients and helping them to maintain their dignity in their own homes. For a short period of time, she even worked with her family running a pizzeria franchise which she loved.

Though she held many jobs over the years, her crowning achievement was her family. This was where she truly shone and put in the most work. She was a traditionalist with strong family values. Her efforts were concentrated and it showed. She was a consummate professional homemaker who made her house a home for everyone. Her finest traits and virtues were on display when she was with her family. One of her greatest blessings was becoming a grandmother, and she carried her wonderful motherly skills into the next generation.

Linda loved to laugh and had a way of making every moment more enjoyable. She loved to dance to '80s music with her husband, especially Hall & Oates. If a song had a beat, she was on the dance floor. They were the quintessential dance couple. She loved nothing more than being a supportive mother to all her children in their endeavors, especially at hockey games. She never missed ice time, she could always be seen cheering loudest of all the fellow hockey parents, many of whom became fast friends. When her children had any life issues she would tell them, "keep on keeping on." She was one of the first females to join the young men's organization the Utica Jaycees.

Linda is survived by her beloved husband, Louis; children and their spouses, Marialena A. and Stash Zielinski, Suzanne Denato and Kenny Gotte, Louis D.
