Mr. Louis Anthony Mancuso, age 78, passed away at his home unexpectedly on Thursday, January 24, 2013 with the love and support of his family.

Born in Utica on August 21, 1934, Louis was the son of the late John and Jennie (Massi) Mancuso. Raised and educated locally, he was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. He furthered his studies at the Albany College of Pharmacy where he earned his Degree as a Licensed Pharmacist. On September 7, 1964 he married the former Rosemarie Colonnelli with whom he shared a 48-year union of love and understanding.

A successful retail pharmacist, he owned and operated Berke's Drugs for many years in Rome, NY. More recently he was employed with Rite Aid Pharmacy, the position from which he retired in 2008.
