Mr. Louis "Louie" Rabideau, age 42, of Forestport, passed away on Tuesday, January 12, 2016 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with his family by his side, after a brief illness.

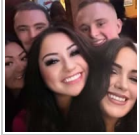

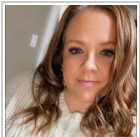
