Her personality was one that would draw others to her and then develop into a fast closeness. She was always willing to help and go out of her way for people. Holidays and birthdays brought her much joy, and she tried to make each of

them a memorable celebration. Lynda loved having her family over every Sunday for dinner. She enjoyed camping in the Adirondacks and her yearly family excursions to Saratoga, Florida, and many other destinations. She liked to spend her time at the Casino and try her luck at games of chance. She was also loved dearly by her feline companion "Libby". She was a communicant of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.
