Mr. Marco P. Indolfi, age 83, of Utica, passed away peacefully on Saturday, September 25, 2010 at the St. Luke's Home.

Born in Utica on December 11, 1926, Marco was the son of the late Frank and Antoinette (Annese) Indolfi. He was raised and educated locally, and attended T. R. Proctor High School. A proud veteran, he served his country stateside in the United States Army. At one time he was married to the former Anne (Tartaglia) Famolaro.

Marco's creative artistry with a camera defined and inspired his 33 years of service to the Griffiss Air Force Base as a photographer. Concurrently, he was employed by NuArt Photography, where he specialized in wedding photography with his business partner, Peter Zizzi.
