January 3, 1927 - May 4, 2023

UTICA - Mrs. Marianne F. (Cucci) Pecheone, age 96, passed peacefully on Thursday, May 4, 2023 with the love of her family in her heart.

Born in Utica on January 3, 1927, Marianne was the daughter of the late Vincenzo and Palma (Pinto) Cucci. She was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1945. On June 30, 1951 she married Carmen Carl Pecheone. They were extremely devoted to each other and shared such an admirable affection for over 56 years prior to his passing on May 15, 2008.

During World War II, Marianne worked diligently at the Oneita Knitting Mill for the War efforts. Upon the birth of her first child she dedicated her time to being a housewife and stay-at-home mom and with the blessing of two more children, her greatest joy and job was being a full-time mother. Marianne was an astonishing matriarch who knew how to teach her children core values with the intention that they would be the best they could be. Her home was a safe place, and elegantly adorned with antique blue plates. She enjoyed a daily automobile ride with her husband, a tranquil time for both of them. Marianne met with her friends of "The Girls' Club" for over 60 years, often twice a month. They shared much love, and many happy times and occasions that were so meaningful and memorable. Their forever friendships were solid and faithful. There are two remaining members who were in constant contact, Dolores "Dee" Chieco, and Concetta "Connie" Della Gala, and the numerous girls of the group who had gone before Marianne but were never forgotten. A woman of spirit and generosity, Marianne bestows her virtues to her

greatest loves, Carmen C. and Victoria Lee Pecheone; and Mariangela Pecheone. Marianne survived the greatest tribulation in life, losing her beloved daughter, Joanne Palma Pecheone who passed away on January 12, 1972. She leaves to cherish her memory her grandson, John Carlo Pecheone who was the light of her life and called her grandmama; and brother, Peter Cucci, who was loyal and devoted to his sister and was so attentive to Marianne's needs. Because of the age difference, she was truly a second mother to him throughout the years. She was preceded by her brother, Anthony P. Cucci; and her sister and brother-in-law, Isabella and James Shanley. She also leaves several nieces, nephews, great-nieces, and great-nephews. The family, especially Marianne, were so grateful for the compassion and commitment of the past District Attorneys as well as the current D.A. Scott McNamara, Investigator James Helmer who never exhausted his commitment to Joanne's case, the D.A. Task Force, and the Utica Police and New York State Police; it was their efforts that finally gave her some peace. Throughout her life, Marianne was an attentive and passionate friend to so many. She held a special relationship with her daughter-in-law's mother, Gertrude "Trudy" Garvey. She was predeceased by her father-in-law and mother-in-law, Carmine and Jennie (Grande) Pecheone; and in-laws, Marie (Pecheone) and John Eck, Raymond/UPD and Anne Pecheone, and Kathleen (Pecheone) and Rollin Tuttle.
