



Marie T. (Mazza) Brennan

August 5, 1936 - March 15, 2011

Mrs. Marie T. (Mazza) Brennan, age 74, of North Utica, passed away on Tuesday, March 15, 2011 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with the love and support of her family by her side.

Born in Utica on August 5, 1936, Marie was the daughter of the late Salvie and Rose (Arcuri) Mazza. She was proud to have been raised at her family's loving Catherine Street homestead and educated locally. She was a graduate of T.R.
