UTICA - Mrs. Marie D. (DeBernardis) Carbone, age 88, fought a courageous battle but succumbed to it on Thursday, February 11, 2021 with the love and support of her family in her heart.

Born in Utica on November 25, 1932, Marie was the daughter of the late Serafino, Sr. and Lucia (DeRisio) DeBernardis. She was raised and educated locally. On September 15, 1951 she married her childhood sweetheart, John N. Carbone, Jr. and shared with him a lifetime commitment of nearly 62 years, prior to his passing on April 22, 2013. Theirs was an absolutely perfect match of mutual respect, love, and admiration. They remained in each other's hearts on earth, and now John and his "Mer" are together for all time.

During her younger years, prior to starting a family, Marie worked for the Kordeen Dress Manufacturing Company as well as the Oneita Knitting Mill, but her full-time position was being a wonderful mother to seven children- Amen! A great wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and great-great-grandmother, her four generations of children were the joy of her life. Her warm and welcoming ambience made every occasion special and meaningful. She respected everyone and had a humanitarian love for God's people. She was thoughtful, kind, generous, and respectful. She lived a simple life that was blessed with love since her own childhood, and then with her marriage to John and the arrival of their children, she grew to know even more love. All her relationships were precious to her and she was thankful for every day and the blessings that came with them. She was truly one of a kind

and was held in great admiration by all who knew and loved her. She lived the word of God and his teaching that “Those who work hard will prosper and be satisfied, Amen”. (Proverbs 15:4)

During a very memorable time in her life, she looked forward to her Thursday afternoon club meetings with her sisters, an uplifting time for all. She enjoyed the art of crocheting blankets as gifts for her multi-generations of offspring, and prior to her passing she completed her last blanket for her great-granddaughter. Baking holiday specialties was so important to her and she delivered a “giving plate” abundantly filled and made with love, a personal endeavor graciously received by those she intended to connect with. Marie embraced life with sincerity and raised a close-knit, respectful family. She was one of the loveliest people anyone could know, for many reasons. Every Sunday, after Mass, the family gathered at Marie’s home for a feast, complete with all the traditional Italian specialties, her personal way of saying “I love you”.

Marie was the last chartered member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Knights of St. John/Auxiliary #385. Her personal acts of piety touched many lives as she believed in the power of prayers of petition to fill other’s needs. Marie and John were lifetime parishioners of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church and active members of the Order of St. Frances prayer group.
