Mrs. Marie A. "Timmy" (Paciello) Chiarello, age 96, of Utica, passed away on Wednesday, July 27, 2011 at the Masonic Care Community of NY with the love and support of her family by her side.

Marie was born in Utica on March 15, 1915, the daughter of the late Girardo A. and Marie Guiseppe (Fiore) Paciello; she was the last surviving child of ten children. She was raised and educated locally. On July 24, 1943 she married Alfred S. "Doc" Chiarello who passed away on Christmas Day in 1950. Timmy was admired for her devoted care of her husband during their unfortunately short marriage. From this union came the blessing of a daughter, Dina, who cared for her mother to the very end.

She was courageous and nurturing at heart, and a snapshot of her life would include the dedication and care she unconditionally gave to her parents, siblings, and family. There was no one 'quite like her'. She was thankful for the enthusiasm and energy to share life with her grandchildren and great-grandchildren who truly adored

her. She was a parishioner of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish.

Timmy is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Geraldine C. "Dina" and Joseph E. Russo, Jr. of Utica; her grandchildren, Joseph A. "Joey" Russo of Utica, and Christopher "Chris" and Crystal Russo of Rome; and her great-grandchildren, Ashley, Danielle, Gabrielle, Michael, Joseph, Mason, Samantha, and Brevin. She also leaves several nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, and very special and loving in-laws, Flora Gulla and her children Al and Sharon who showed their respect with calls and visits, and Blase and Carol Chiarello. Timmy held a special place in her heart for the members of the Tomassetti family, especially acknowledging Marilyn Sardina and Jacqueline Farrell who she considered family.
