She was fastidious with her home and her appearance - she was a wonder! Marie was a gentle soul and a free spirit in many aspects of her life. She was born into the Catholic faith.

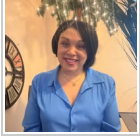

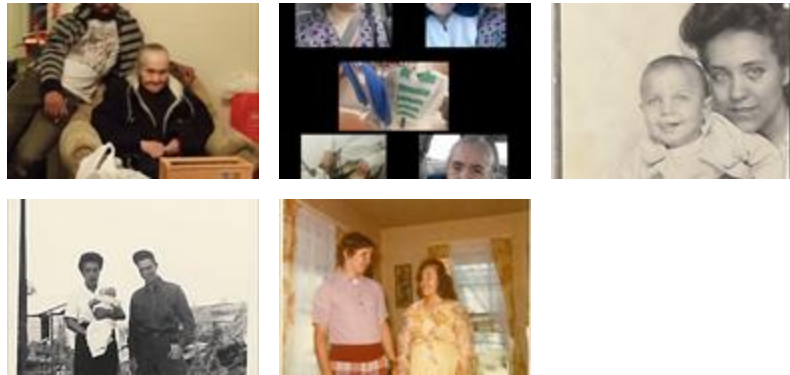
