



## Mrs. Marie Nancy (Paciello) Pandolfo

March 25, 1928 - April 15, 2021

UTICA - Mrs. Marie Nancy (Paciello) Pandolfo, age 93, passed away peacefully after a long illness on Thursday, April 15, 2021.

Born in Utica on March 25, 1928, Marie was the daughter of the late Rocco D. and Louise (Salvatore) Paciello. She attended local schools and was a proud graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1948. Marie found joy in sharing fond memories of growing up in East Utica during the 1930's, 40's and 50's and making lifelong friendships. She enjoyed family life on her beloved Lansing Street, a neighborhood of people who shared common traditions of an Italian heritage, and who worked hard to provide their children the opportunity to attend college, and acquire a profession to earn a living. Marie was united in marriage to Anthony F. Pandolfo on June 27, 1953 at St. Mary of Mt. Carmel Church, a blessed union of 57 years prior to his passing on January 31, 2011. They were an inseparable couple blessed with a happy home life and two sons who were included in everything they did as a family. Marie worked as a bookkeeper for several notable companies prior to her marriage. She paused to raise her children and then re-entered the workforce as a Payroll Clerk at the Duxbak Corporation where she was employed for a number of years until the company's closing.

Marie was a loving and caring wife, mother, mema, daughter, and sister, and she always put the needs of others before herself. A benevolent friend and mentor, her door was always open to all with kind words, support, and good food in times of tribulation and times of celebration. That was a way of life in

that era, for a generation who would lend a hand or a shoulder to lean on, and she embraced it and loved those times. Hospitality was her hallmark and she welcomed all with sincerity. At one time, her craftsmanship could be seen in her knitting, crocheting, and sewing for her family. She was grateful to be the kind of mother who instilled the importance of education and guided her children to strive for higher learning and an honest life well-lived.

Marie was a devout Catholic and communicant of St. Mary of Mt.

Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish and a member of the St. Anne Society.

Until her later years, she faithfully attended early Sunday morning Mass. It was at Mt. Carmel that she was baptized, confirmed, married, and wanted to have her Mass of Christian Burial celebrated. It was the church that grounded her in God's word and did so until the end of her days.

Marie is survived by her sons and daughter-in-law, Anthony Pandolfo, and Rocco A. and Rosella Pandolfo; her grandchildren, Robert and Nicole Horne, Christina Marie and Eric Griffith, Amanda Pandolfo and fiancé Ivan Aponte; Anthony Joseph Pandolfo, Louisa Marie Pandolfo, and Rocco D. Pandolfo; great-grandchildren, Jessica, Robert, and Leonard; and Scarlett Elizabeth; and her brother and sister-in-law, Daniel and Theresa Paciello. She will also be remembered by her many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins; and Rose Saba, her childhood and lifelong friend of whom she cherished. She was predeceased by her sister and brother-in-law, Angela and Salvatore "Sal" D'Amico, Jr.; her father-in-law and mother-in-law, Antonio and Eleanor Pandolfo; in-laws, Mary and John Granieri, Philip and Gloria Pandolfo, Delores Pandolfo, Theresa Pandolfo, and Rosalie and Joseph Isgro; nieces, Adeleen Stephens, Eleanor Visalli, and Lois Pugh; and her nephew, Donald D'Amico.

The family wishes to thank the Charles T. Sitrin Home Health Care staff at the Magnolia House who cared for Marie with love and compassion; and long time home health aide, Sue Hurd who provided comfort and care to Marie and was a blessing to all.

The family will honor and commemorate Marie's life at a private time. Family

and friends are respectfully invited to attend Marie's funeral service and Celebration of Life which will commence on Monday, April 26th at 11:00 at St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish, 648 Jay Street where her Mass of Christian Burial will be offered. COVID-19 protocols and precautions will be observed. Face masks covering your nose and mouth are required and social distancing and contact tracing will be implemented.
