MARCY/UTICA – On Thursday, September 25, 2025, Mrs. Marie S. (Piperata) Morreale, age 92, passed away peacefully, reuniting with her beloved Russell and other loved ones who had gone before her. Her family was by her side, their hearts filled with gratitude for a life so beautifully lived.

Born in Utica on August 15, 1933, Marie was the daughter of the late Dominick J. and Laura M. (Pazzola) Piperata. She was one of nine siblings in a large and lively Italian family and was raised and educated locally.

On September 20, 1958, Marie married the love of her life, Rosario J. “Russell” Morreale II. Their blessed union lasted over 33 years, until Russell’s passing on January 29, 1992. They dedicated their lives to one another, balancing the joys of raising their children while owning and operating Rosario’s Pizzerias. She fondly remembered her years working at General Electric and as a waitress at several local establishments.

Marie possessed a kind and selfless spirit. She was truly the best mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, sister, and friend anyone could ask for. Deeply proud of her Italian heritage, she cherished her roots and lovingly passed down cherished traditions to her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren, who were the light of her life. Her home was a haven of warmth and hospitality, always filled with snacks, laughter, and an abundance of love.

As everyone's greatest supporter, she devoted her life to her family and created a lasting legacy of love that will continue for generations to come.

Marie was a passionate New York Yankees fan who rarely missed a game. She celebrated every win with the same energy and dedication she showed in all areas of her life, often sporting her beloved Yankee apparel. She also loved a good card game of skat but wasn't fond of losing! A devoted parishioner of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish, Marie's faith was central to her life. She faithfully attended weekly services with her siblings, always holding her rosary close.

Marie will be remembered for these countless little moments that defined her: cherished memories at the pizzeria, her fierce loyalty to those she loved, and the way her face lit up whenever her family walked into the room. She truly lived life to the fullest—celebrating each day, standing tall through challenges, always finding joy in the simple things: family, friends, laughter, and a Yankees win. She loved to dance and was always the last one to leave the dance floor at any occasion.
