



Marion A. (Sciallo) Coniglio

August 14, 1926 - November 4, 2012

Mrs. Marion A. (Sciallo) Coniglio, age 86, of Utica, passed away on Sunday, November 4, 2012 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center.

Born in Manhattan on August 14, 1926, Marion was the daughter of the late Frederico and Maria (Siriani) Sciallo. She was raised and educated in Brooklyn. At one time she was married to Philip Mangiamele. On January 24, 1953, she married Joseph Coniglio with whom she shared 29 years in a union filled with love and devotion until his passing in 1982.

Marion began her career working for the Civil Service during the war. Later, over the course of many years, she was employed as a proofreader and computer operator, and also as a dental assistant, all positions that she held while residing in Brooklyn. More recently, she was employed as a secretary at the East Utica Senior Center for 9 years. She was a communicant of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish.

Mrs. Coniglio is survived by two sons, Philip Mangiamele and Gil Mangiamele. She was preceded in death by one son, Fred Coniglio, whose memory she cherished in her heart.
