Mrs. Marjorie A. "Marge" (Rehm) Brown, age 75, of Utica, passed away on Saturday, April 22, 2006 at the Heritage Health Care Center with her family by her side.

Born in Utica on August 19, 1930, Marjorie was the daughter of the late James D. and Sadie A. Rehm. She graduated from Oriskany High School as Salutatorian of the Class of 1948. At one time she was married to the late James L. Brown.

Over the course of her working career, Mrs. Brown was employed with the Utica Mutual Insurance Co. and also with the Utica YWCA. She provided conscientious and loyal service in her positions with both organizations. Marge possessed a strong faith, a loving heart, and a selfless spirit.
