PITTSBURGH, PENNSYLVANIA - Mark J. Scarafile, 59, of East Liverpool, Ohio passed away in the arms of his children on Wednesday, June 9, 2021 at West Penn Hospital in Pittsburgh, PA after a short illness.

Mark was born in Utica on September 17, 1961. He was a graduate of New Hartford High School/Class of 1980 and Riverside School of Aeronautics in Utica. He worked at Pittsburgh International Airport for 37 years as a quality control supervisor for American Airlines. In this supervisory position Mark made numerous trips to Germany to act as a liaison handling many aspects such as planning, testing, inspecting, and coordinating the purchase of new airplanes. Mark had a passion for rebuilding and restoring automobiles. Some of his greatest restorations included his Jeeps and Pontiac GTO which he built from the ground up.
