March 6, 1922 - November 5, 2006

Mrs. Martha (Putrelo) Scott, age 84, of New Hartford, passed away on Sunday, November 5, 2006, at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with her family by her side.

Born in Utica on March 6, 1922, Martha was the daughter of the late Maurizio and Rose (Laria) Putrelo. Raised and educated locally, she was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. On September 26, 1953 she married Harold B. Scott with whom she shared a union of 47 years until his passing on January 8, 2001.

Martha furthered her studies at the Utica State Hospital, where she earned her license as a Registered Nurse. Her nursing career began at the Oneida County Hospital. She later worked at Broadacres Skilled Nursing Facility, and for 23 years was employed at St. Elizabeth Hospital as an operating room nurse, a profession from which she retired in 1988. She honored her devotion to nursing through her leadership skills and the enjoyment of the diversity of her positions. She was a member of the Association of Operating Room Nurses. As a pastime, Martha took pleasure in her painting classes at the Munson-Williams-Proctor Arts Institute. She frequented the Genesee St. Senior Center, and proudly served with the T.R. Proctor Reunion Committee. She found television to be her connection to education and entertainment. Her most treasured accomplishment was affirmed in the proud feelings she held in her heart for her cherished grandchildren. She was of the Catholic faith. Martha is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Lorraine S. and George E.

Curtis of Utica; her beloved grandchildren, Dr. Michael S. Curtis and his fiancée Michelle Wania of St. Louis, MO, and Melissa R. Curtis of Utica. In addition, she leaves several nieces, especially acknowledging Francine “Pudge” Mikalajunas, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, and cousins; and her sister-in-law, Louella Plunkett of Broadalbin, NY.
