



## Mary (Stratico) Marco

January 27, 1911 - January 30, 2006

Mrs. Mary (Stratico) Marco, age 95, of Utica, passed away on Monday, January 30, 2006, at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with her family by her side.
