



Mrs. Mary M. (Miullo) Decker

October 21, 1916 - June 15, 2015

Mrs. Mary M. (Miullo) Decker, age 98, passed away peacefully on Monday, June 15, 2015 at the Masonic Care Community of NY.

Born in Utica on October 21, 1916, Mary was the daughter of the late Cesare and Rose (Villanova) Miullo. Raised and educated locally, she was a graduate of Utica Free Academy. During World War II, she worked at the former Rome Air Depot where she rose to the position of supervisor of the Teletype Department. It was there that she met her future husband, Robert V. Decker, then a sergeant in the US Army Air Corps. They were married on January 31, 1945 and made their home in Utica.

Mary became a full-time homemaker and dedicated her life to her husband, children, and parents. She shared 24 years with Bob prior to his passing on November 13, 1969. Mary then resumed working, and was employed as a Senior Stenographer with the Utica City School District. Mary was known for her gardening, cooking, and sewing and also pursued other pastimes including oil painting and needlepoint. She was always an avid student, continuously seeking to learn more to improve her skills. She practiced her Catholic faith as a communicant of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.

Mary enriched the lives of her surviving family, including her sons, daughter, and their spouses, John and Patricia Decker of Utica, Robert and Teresa Decker of New Hartford, and Rosemary Mohl of Scottsdale, AZ; her grandchildren, John and Victoria Decker, Shelley and Anthony Spatto, Kathryn and Jeremy Branstad, and Nicholas Decker; her great-grandchildren, Ava,

Emma, and Julia Decker; her sister, Sarah (Rosky) Femia; and several nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, and cousins. She was predeceased by her brothers Michael, and Nathaniel.

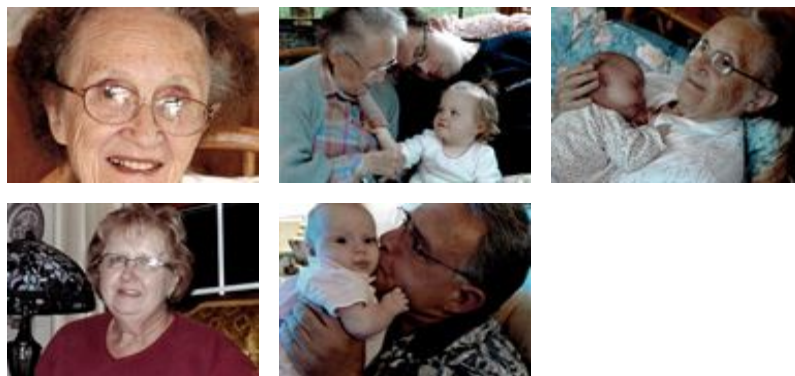
