Mary A. (Falvo) Fierro, age 97, passed away peacefully on Saturday, May 11, 2013 at St. Elizabeth Medical Center with her loving family by her side.

rooted for the NY Yankees as well as the NY Knicks. Mary was ever present to the Lord in her heart and recited the rosary daily and kept many people in her prayers. She was a parishioner of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish.

Giovinazzo, Jr., all of New Hartford and all who lovingly carried out daily commitments to Mary's care.
