Mrs. Mary A. (Nole) Morgan, age 84, passed away peacefully on Sunday, May 29, 2016 at the Presbyterian Home for Central NY. At the time, she was surrounded by the love of her family.

Born in Utica on May 20, 1932, Mary was the daughter of the late John A. and Angeline M. (DeLorenzo) Nole. Raised and educated locally, she was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1950. On May 23, 1953 she married Andrew J. Morgan with whom she shared her love, her life, and the blessing of their family for 42 years. Their hard work and words of wisdom provided their children everything they needed to become responsible adults. Andy passed away on October 25, 1995.

Mary held many memories of the early years of her life with Andy when he served in the United States Navy. They were living in Boston and upon the birth of their first child, they returned to Utica. Mary was a dutiful mom and caring for her children came first and foremost. She found time to volunteer for several Parent/Teacher Association jobs and hold full-time employment at Banker's Trust, later known as Key Bank, the position from which she retired as Head Teller. Mary had an easy-going personality and never gave in to the pressures of life. She accepted the ups and the downs with grace and great faith. She guided her children, gave them good advice, and put their needs before her own. She also loved her extended family with an open heart. Mary followed time-honored traditions and celebrated holidays with festive decorations and delicious homemade meals. At Christmas, each child was

treated equally and shared in the magic of the season. As a grandmother and great-grandmother, she blossomed with the birth of her grandchildren and great-grandchildren and bonded with them throughout their childhood years. She knew just what to do. Her hobbies included crocheting and each of her kids, grandkids, and great-grandkids were bestowed with an “afghan” in the appointed pink or blue color. She enjoyed playing cards and Pokeno on Sunday nights, games of chance, and in her younger years, bowling in leagues. She volunteered at the Good News Foundation and her spirituality was the basis for the good life she led. In the past, she was a parishioner of Blessed Sacrament Church where she participated in Bible Study and a Prayer Group. She was currently a communicant of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish.

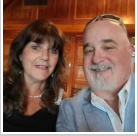
