



Mr. Matthew Bryan Vescera

September 8, 1986 - January 12, 2021

FRANKFORT, NY - On Tuesday, January 12, 2021, Matthew Bryan Vescera passed away at home surrounded by his loving family, after a valiant battle with cancer. He was 34 years old.

Born in Utica on September 8, 1986, Matthew was the son of Frank and Gloria (Williams) Vescera. He was a graduate of Poland Central High School/Class of 2005. He furthered his studies at Utica College of Syracuse University where he earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in History. On May 3, 2014 he married the former Shannon McCraith. They started out as friends, were bonded by marriage, and were each other's hearts to the very end. Nearly 11 months ago, they were blessed with their beautiful baby Camilla Abigail whom he loved dearly.

Matthew worked in the technology industry and was credited with having a great work ethic. He especially loved working with his Dad in the family business from an early age. To know Matthew was to instantly love him. He always had a smile on his face and was ready with a helping hand for anything anyone needed. He was young at heart, loved playing video games and all things Nintendo, Superman, DC Comics, and building Lego models. He enjoyed road trips with Shannon to various breweries throughout New York and New England. He was also an avid historian and loved debating with anyone who would engage with him.

Although he was a father for only a short time, Matthew adored his baby girl and he was so proud to be her dad. She will grow up knowing how strong and

courageous her father was, especially when faced with adversity.

Matthew is survived by his parents, Frank and Gloria; his wife and best friend, Shannon; adored daughter, Camilla Abigail Vescera; brother, James Vescera and his fiancée Jacqueline Taylor; and his sister, Kristen Vescera. He also leaves his maternal grandparents, Ronald and Patricia Williams; nieces, Isabella and Madalin; great-niece, Haylee; mother-in-law, Mary McCraith; in-laws, Shauna and Kasey Eakins; godchildren, Alexandria and Jackson Cleveland; uncles and aunts, cousins, and countless friends. He was predeceased by his paternal grandparents, I. Frank Vescera and Josephine (Longo) Vescera; and his father-in-law, Thomas M. McCraith III.

The family extends their sincere appreciation to Dr. Alicia DeTraglia, an amazing physician who guided Matthew and his family through the process; and the staff of the Regional Cancer Center who were so welcoming and comforting. Matthew was hospitalized at MVHS at St. Luke's Healthcare Center where the nurses and staff took personal care of Matthew as well as Shannon. It was his personality blended with adversity that made him a great patient, beloved by the staff.

Relatives and friends are respectfully invited to attend Matthew's funeral service and Celebration of Life which will commence on Monday morning, January 25, 2021 at 11:00 at the Church of Our Lady of Lourdes where his Mass of Christian Burial will be offered.

Social distancing will be implemented and a mask covering your nose and mouth will be required. Please arrive a few moments early for registration for contact tracing. Also, Memorial donations may be made to the family allowing them to establish an educational fund for his cherished daughter, Camilla Abigail. Envelopes will be available at the service.

Like the outpouring from so many others has stated, no words I'll write here can provide enough comfort or articulate the impact Matt, "V," had on so many. Knowing that, I'll attempt the impossible task to share how special Matt was to me and so many others.

The last 15 years, through school, work, and travel has had me meet thousands of people. To this day, I find it hard pressed to say that I've ever met a more pure, authentic, selfless, or positive person than V. I'm not sure I will. Everyone has their measuring sticks, Matt is true north on my compass for being a "good person," and I bet many have him pegged the same.

I remember him winning Prom King for a simple reason, he was the easy choice as the best guy at the event and everyone loved him. A lighter testimonial on this point, I remember (the only time I can recall) Matt getting sent to in school suspension, but it was my fault bc I asked to borrow a pencil and the substitute teacher, not knowing Matt well, caught him turning around to give it to me so she told him to "get out." I couldn't take it, Matt's sterling reputation was not going to be diminished. I argued to this point and then told the teacher, "if he's going, so am I..." we ended up sitting next to each other in detention. But it wasn't just us, Matt being sent out, was to the class, like the Red Sox winning the World Series to Matt, it just wasn't right. Matt's exodus made the class lose it, while some students were sent to detention that day for other reasons, the mass just lost it when they saw this happen. Ultimately so many kids ended up in detention, most had to sit on the floor. Matt was universally loved, I never once heard someone, literally ever, say anything bad about him. Its almost impossible, but it's the truth.

I'll carry memories of Matt for the rest of my life. He was the driver of many firsts for me - seeing Yankee stadium; playing golf (he had to teach me); eating pizza with the sauce on top; trying (and failing) to play an instrument where he shined; going to the Sons of Italy as a clear "guest," and the list goes on. You know you have a great

friend when doing the routine is so much fun when together – driving around watching football/playing video games in the basement; me always hoping the Patriots would lose and Matt always being happy bc it never happened – these simple activities always enhanced simply bc V was there. Laughs were more frequent and lasted longer, any sort of stress/tension nonexistent, and a contagious smile. This was Matt's gift – he enhanced every room and situation he was in. You just wanted to be around him bc he made you feel good and it was fun.

I am and will be a better person in my life for having known Matt bc he set the bar so high. He's someone I'll never forget. My best to his family, friends, and the vast number of individuals he impacted; we're all missing V.
