Mr. Maurice E. "Morris" Doolen, age 79, of Frankfort, passed away on Monday, March 10, 2008 with his family by his side.

Born in Frankfort, NY on July 29, 1928, Maurice was the son of the late David and Ida (Axon) Doolen. He was raised in Frankfort and attended T. R. Proctor High School. A veteran of the U. S. Army, he served his country from 1951-1953.
