Mr. Michael A. Caputo, Sr., age 63, of Utica, passed away on Tuesday, November 27, 2007 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center following a brief illness. His loving family was by his side at the time of his passing.

Born in Utica on May 1, 1944, Michael was the son of the late Nicholas P. and Mary (Getz) Caputo. He was raised and educated locally. A proud veteran, he served his country in the U.S. Army.
