Mr. Michael E. Lawrie, Sr., age 69, of Mohawk, passed away on Wednesday, January 24, 2007, at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with his loving family by his side.

Born in Oneonta, NY on December 22, 1937, Michael was the son of the late Mack Vincent and Mary M. (Amitrano) Lawrie. He was raised and educated in Utica. As a veteran of the US Air Force, he served his country in Greenland, England, and Massachusetts. Upon his discharge from the service, he moved to Oneonta. At one time he was married to the former Andrea Fair.

Michael was a railroad foreman for the Delaware-Hudson Railroad, and supervised rail repairs in the Oneonta-Binghamton area. He was a member of the Mohawk Valley Computer Users Group, the Boys Scouts in Laurens, NY, the Valley Bachelors, and a volunteer at the Community Health and Behavioral Service Center. He was of the Roman Catholic faith.

Michael is survived by his daughters and their families, Michelle and Laurent Michalkovic of New Hartford, and Laura Lawrie and Jerriel Smith of Oneonta; his son and daughter-in-law, Michael and Debbie Lawrie of Utica; and his grandchildren, Amelie and Stefen.
