UTICA - Mr. Nicholas M. Angerosa, Jr., age 61, passed away after a rather brief illness on Wednesday, April 11, 2018 with his loving family by his side. Born in Utica on April 13, 1956, Nicholas was the son of Marie (Flo) Angerosa and the late Nicholas M. Angerosa. He was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1974 and continued his education at MVCC graduating in 1976 with a degree in Banking, Real Estate and Insurance. Nick began his career at Oneida National Bank as a teller and repossessed cars for the bank also at the East Utica branch and well as the downtown location. He subsequently worked for the City of Utica at the Water Board. In his last position he was the Foreman in the Meter Shop.

Nick had a quiet and serene personality. He had a special love and appreciation for his mom, and he depended upon his sister throughout their childhood, and as adults, he came to know her as an advocate. His brother-in-law Bernie was a buddy who bolstered his spirits and made him laugh. His nieces lit up his life and his great-niece Amelia was a special little angel. Nick's interests included automobiles, and he especially loved muscle cars. During his youth, he was a skillful sportsman participating in ice hockey, football, and bowling, and for most of his life, he enjoyed golfing and watching The Masters. He followed professional baseball, hockey, and football and was a fan of the New York Yankees, New York Rangers, and the Dallas Cowboys. He was a passionate music lover and he favored the music of the 1970's. He had an appreciation for animals, showing a very compassionate nature

towards all. Nicholas was proud of the fact he came to know his dog, who he truly loved, who he rescued.

Nicholas is survived by his mother, Marie who has been a wonderful caretaker and one of great support; his sister and brother-in-law, DeeAnne and Bernie Tomaino; nieces, Adana Tomaino who was also his goddaughter, Ava and Wayne Perrigo and their daughter Amelia Marie; his aunts, Carol Angerosa, Sandy Pryputniewicz, and Betty Angerosa, his uncle Raymond and Patricia Fiore; and the blessing of many cousins. He also leaves Joseph Gabiger, a lifelong friend of the family. He was predeceased by his godfather and uncle, Frank Angerosa; and numerous aunts and uncles.
