UTICA/SALINAS, PR - Mr. Norberto Rosado, age 68, passed away on Thursday, December 31, 2020 due to COVID-19. His passing occurred at MVHS at St. Luke's Healthcare with his loving family by his side.

Born in Salinas, Puerto Rico on October 9, 1952, Norberto was the son of the late Teofilo and Carmen (Tolentino) Rosado. As an infant, he moved with his family to the United States where he has since resided. He attended T.R. Proctor High School.
