



## Nyalueth M. Geng

January 1, 1966 - November 8, 2010

Nyalueth M. Geng, age 44, of Utica, passed away on Monday, November 8, 2010 in the dignity and comfort of The Abraham House.

Born in Sudan, Africa on January 1, 1966, Nyalueth was the daughter of Makuor Geng and Akec Takpeng. Raised and educated in Sudan, she immigrated to Utica from her native country. She was married to Mathok Ban. Nyalueth worked hard to support her family in Utica. She was employed as an assembler at various businesses including D.B. Smith & Co., Inc., LaSalle Laboratories in Little Falls, Keymark Corporation in Fonda, and Kurt Weiss Greenhouse on Herkimer Road, until her illness. Nyalueth was a loving, kind, happy, and social woman who enjoyed the company of others, often lending support and wise words of advice to her family and her children, who were her mainstay. She also offered her time and gentle guidance to the local Sudanese women in the community, and those who struggled in adjusting and integrating into their new environment. She welcomed everyone to her home and was a second mother to many of her compatriots, encouraging them to better themselves and utilize the many resources offered to the area's new arrivals. She also loved to cook, sing, and watch movies. She was a parishioner of Historic Old St. John's Church.

Nyalueth is survived by her daughters, Panda Madit, Nyaroor Madit, Aman Madit, Nyachida Madit, and Ashok Madit; and her sons, Gabriel Madit, and Makur Madit. Always close to her heart was the memory of her son who preceded her in death. Survivors also include her large and loving extended

family.

Visitation will be held Saturday afternoon from 12:00-1:00 at Historic Old St. John's Church. Nyalueth's funeral service and Celebration of Life will commence on Saturday afternoon at 1:00 at Historic Old St. John's Church immediately upon the conclusion of visitation, where her Mass of Christian Burial will be offered by Rev.
