Mr. Pablo Davila, age 73, a resident of the Charles T. Sitrin Health Care Center, passed away on Monday, June 30, 2008 at the Faxon-St. Luke's Healthcare Center.

Born in Salinas, Puerto Rico on January 31, 1935, Pablo was the son of the late Dioniso Espada and Antonia (Davila) Gonzalez. He was raised and educated in Puerto Rico. A proud veteran of the U. S. Army, he honorably served his country from 1952-1955.
