UTICA - Pamela Rose Mazzatti, age 58, went home to be with our Lord when she passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, September 14, 2022.

Born in Utica on May 16, 1964, Pamela was the daughter of Cecilia Mary (Ventimiglia) and the late Robert Michael “Bob” Mazzatti. Raised and educated in Frankfort, NY, she was a graduate of Frankfort High School/Class of 1982. She furthered her studies at MVCC where she received an Associate Degree in Business Administration.

Pamela worked for 28 years as a Health Care Representative at The United Food and Commercial Workers (UFCW). An energetic, engaging employee, she was well-loved and respected by her co-workers and administrators whom she considered her “work family.” Above all, she loved her family and relatives who raised her and shared her life. Pamela possessed a beautiful, humble and giving heart. She radiated a warmth that was felt by everyone she came in contact with. Her smile lit up a room. The neighborhood children loved her nurturing, outgoing nature and referred to her as “Miss Pamela,” a title bestowed with love. She was adored for her acts of kindness and thoughtfulness that will remain as beautiful memories for many.

Pam loved to cook and took pride in her Italian dishes, especially her fresh-from-the-garden, egg-dipped delicacy of fried zucchini flowers. A seasoned gardener, she harvested a bounty of vegetables every year. In the summer, you could also find her tending to and enjoying the family swimming pool — she was a “summertime girl.” She enjoyed family vacations in Florida, visits

with friends and family, long walks, and the magic of sunsets. Pamela practiced her Catholic faith as a parishioner of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel Church. Pamela is survived by her mother, Cecilia; her sister, Mary Christine Mazzatti; her brother, Robert Guy Mazzatti and wife Fredrika. She also leaves her niece, Nicole Wall and husband Alex, nephew Jacob Mazzatti, their mother, Jennifer White and husband Kevin; great-nephews, Cole Wall and Lincoln Wall; uncles and aunts Richard Mazzatti, Daniel Ventimiglia and wife MaryAnn, Ruth O'Brien and husband Richard. Pamela was blessed to share a loving and beautiful relationship for 13 years with Tim Tripp.
