



## Mr. Pasquale J. Putrello (P.J.)

September 13, 1937 - August 7, 2020

UTICA - Mr. Pasquale J. Putrello, age 82, passed away on August 7, 2020 at the Oneida Center for Rehabilitation & Nursing, where he had been a resident.

Born in Utica on September 13, 1937, Pasquale was the son of the late Pasquale J. Sr. and Vincenza (Vendetta) Putrello. He attended local schools and in his earlier years worked at Delorio's Bakery, and lastly at Broadacres Hospital as an Aide, the position from which he retired. P.J. proudly volunteered to help many organizations which included St. Mary of Mount Carmel Church, the Boilermaker road race, Utica Jay-Cees, and La Banda Rosa. Pasquale loved to travel and frequently attended Utica hockey and the Harlem Globetrotter games. Other interests included collecting sports and movie memorabilia, leather crafting, and music.

Pasquale is survived by his sisters and brother-in-law, Margaret and Joseph Montanaro, and Fanny George; his brother and sister-in-law, Joseph and Benita (Sue) Putrelo; and many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, and friends. He was predeceased by three brothers, Dicky Putrello, Jimmy Putrello, and Moe Putrello; two sisters, Rosina Petruello, and Maria Petruello; sister-in-law, Connie Putrello; brother-in-law, William George; and great-niece, Kayla Whitten.
