Patricia A. Mitchell, age 49, of New Hartford, passed away on Saturday, March 17, 2012 in the comfort and dignity of her home.

Born in New Hartford on June 14, 1962, Patricia was the daughter of Winifred “Winnie” (Abbott) Mitchell and the late Louis Joseph Mitchell, Sr. She was a graduate of New Hartford High School Class of 1981.
