



Paul Chopchic

February 1, 1924 - August 1, 2008

Mr. Paul Chopchic, age 84, of New Hartford, passed away on Friday, August 1, 2008 with his loving family by his side.

Born in Belarus in Europe on February 1, 1924, Paul was the son of the late Izadore and Maria (Krukowicz) Chopchic. He was raised and educated in Belarus. He relocated to Canada in 1948 and then to Utica in 1958 to join with his family and has resided here since. In November 1956 in Canada he married the former Martha Chlus with whom he shared a union of 51 years. A tailor by trade, Paul was employed by the Webs, Taylor & Fitter Companies for 10 years, Wicks & Greenman, later known as Wicks-Greenman & Wallachs for 22 years, retiring in 1992 upon the store's closing. Paul was a sports enthusiast and he also enjoyed gardening. He was a parishioner of St. John of Kronstadt Church and a member of the choir.

Paul is survived by his wife, Martha; and his son, George P. Chopchic of New Hartford.
