

Paul (Sefket Isovich) Everest

May 25, 1940 - April 6, 2012

Mr. Paul Everest, born as Sefket Isovich, age 71, of Boonville, passed away on Friday, April 6, 2012 in the comfort of his home with his loving family and friends by his side.

Paul was born in Montenegro in Southeastern Europe on May 25, 1940. He was raised and educated there and moved to the United States as a young man. He worked in the construction and roofing industry and was a member of the Roofers Local 195, Cicero. At one time, he was employed as a dealer at Turning Stone Casino. A generous and loving man, Paul did everything for his family and friends and would often lend a hand to those that he did not know. He devoted time to tending his large vegetable garden, hunting, and fishing, especially for salmon. He was a member of the Bosnian Islamic Association of Utica.

Paul is survived by his son, James Everest, with whom he shared a special paternal bond; his daughters, Sana Everest, with whom he held deep closeness in his heart, Tiffany Everest, and Sabra Everest, all of Boonville, and Elvira Isovich of Europe; and several grandchildren. He also leaves his sister, Nafija Isovich of Sweden; his brother, Ismet Isovich of Germany; several nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, especially Alen Rastoder, and his friends Bob Marmon, and John Frizzel who was like a son. He was predeceased by his brother, Rifko Isovich; and his cousin Hamo Rastoder who was like a brother.

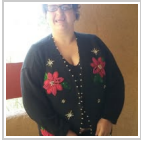
