Mr. Paul S. Curcio, age 76, of New Hartford, passed away on Sunday, November 18, 2007 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center.

Born in Utica on June 21, 1931, Paul was the son of the late Samuel and Lena (Rodio) Curcio. Raised and educated locally, he was a 1950 graduate of T. R. Proctor High School.
