



Mr. Raymond F. "Ray" Hanson

Mr. Raymond F. "Ray" Hanson, age 82, passed away on Wednesday, March 4, 2015 in the comfort of his home with his family by his side.

Born in Utica on February 28, 1933, Raymond was the son of the late Amos and Edith A. (Weaver) Hanson. Raised and educated locally, he attended Utica Free Academy. A proud veteran of the United States Army, he honorably served his country from 1953-1955 stationed stateside. On November 23, 1957 he married the former Amelia "Amy" Longo with whom he shared 51 years prior to her passing on September 21, 2009.

Ray was employed by the General Electric Company/Radio Receiver Plant on Broad Street where he worked as a Designer. He was proud of his ability to design intricate radio mechanisms, the several patents granted by the company, and the accolades he received. He retired in 1999.
