



## Raymond J. Cote

January 21, 1917 - December 17, 2006

Mr. Raymond J. Cote, age 89, currently a resident of Whitesboro, NY and formerly of Gettysburg, PA and Bayside, Queens, NY, passed away on Sunday, December 17, 2006 at the Faxon-St. Luke's Healthcare Center. Born in Fall River, MA on January 21, 1917, Raymond was the son of the late Joseph P. and Clementine (Campeaux) Cote. A veteran of World War II, he served with the U.S. Army. On March 4, 1943, he was joined in marriage with the former Gertrude Davis with whom he has shared a union of 63 years. After attending the Police Academy in NYC, Mr. Cote served as a Patrolman with the 13th Precinct of the NYC Police Dept. for 29 years prior to his retirement. He was of the Catholic faith.

Mr. Cote is survived by his wife, Gertrude; a daughter, Nancy Cote Baber and her husband Robert of Westmoreland, NY; a son and daughter-in-law, Thomas J. and Lori Cote of Newtown, CT; a sister, Yolande Zadigian of NJ; and a number of nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, and in-laws. He was predeceased by 3 brothers and a sister-in-law, Henri G. and Marian Cote, Rene Cote, and Paul Cote; and a sister, Lucille Cote.
