UTICA - Mr. Richard A. Guido, Sr., age 73, went to the Lord, as well as to his children who were awaiting him, when he passed away on Tuesday, February 13, 2018 with his loving family at his side.

Born in Utica on April 26, 1944, Rich was the son of the late Flaminio "Flam" and Anna (D'Agostino) Guido. He also knew the love of his step-mother, Amelia (Testa) Guido. He was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1962. On August 28, 1965 he wed the former Rose Marie Gemedschiew with whom he shared 52 loving years in marriage.

At one time, Rich worked alongside his dad at their family business, the Flam Guido Construction Company. He also held positions at TECT Utica. He set a fine example for his children to strive for a strong work ethic.

Rich was energetic and engaged in just about everything that interested him or touched his life. He would detail his cars with great enthusiasm as he prepared for a show. He once belonged to the Soprano's Car Cruzers where he took part in and enjoyed the comradery of fellow Corvette owners. Rich once was a weekly League bowler at the Pin-O-Rama and was a drummer for the Magnificent Yankees Drum Corps. He was a perennial volunteer at the Boilermaker, a zealous NY Yankees fan and also followed Syracuse University Basketball. Rich attended weekly Mass at his parish, St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church; he volunteered at the annual Sts. Cosmas and Damian Feast where he worked the candle booth. He also enjoyed his morning coffee with the guys.

Rich is survived by his wife, Rose; and his son, Richard A. Guido, Jr. Always close to his heart were the memories of his children who preceded him in death, Christine M. Carbone on September 25, 2012, and Michael J. Guido on May 11, 2012. He also leaves his beloved stepmother, Amelia; his brother and sister-in-law, Donald J. and Kathy Guido; nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, special aunt, Josephine Terzo; in-laws, Nancy and Lloyd Clements, Sophia and John Brockway II, Valda and Ron Roberts, and Patricia and Ricardo Castro; and his canine companion, Specks, who already misses Rich.
