



Mr. Richard J. "Rich" Hobaica

February 13, 1957 - June 1, 2025

CLINTON – Mr. Richard J. “Rich” Hobaica, age 68, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, June 1, 2025, in the comfort and dignity of his own home, with his loving wife by his side.

Born in Utica on February 13, 1957, Richard was the son of the late Joseph M. and Nellie (Hickel) Hobaica. He was a graduate of Notre Dame High School/Class of 1975. He then attended Buffalo State College where he earned a bachelor’s degree in fine arts and graphic design. Rich went on to further his education at St. Bonaventure University, where he proudly earned his master’s degree.

On May 14, 1983, Rich was joined in matrimony with the former Maryellen Tomaino. Their union was marked by deep love and devotion, and together they created a lifetime of beautiful memories.

As a Graphic Designer, Rich began his professional career at Rite Aid. He then had the opportunity to join Great American (which became Victory Markets), holding a position locally working throughout the Northeast specializing in graphic design and marketing. He later moved on to Agway Lawn and Garden for 18 years, where he held a marketing and design position that grew the brand across the Northeast. Lastly, he joined PJ Greene, Inc., where he was a major part of their sales and marketing team,

eventually attaining a vice presidency role. Subsequently, he tended bar at various restaurants, which suited him well, as he was a natural conversationalist and people pleaser. He also loved to drive limousines on the weekends and sold furniture at Raymour and Flanigan. His lively personality made him perfectly suited for all these occupations. Rich was not an idle soul and loved to be in the company of others.

His family was everything to him. Above all, he was a fantastic and supportive father and would never hesitate to share his wisdom and advice. In fact, it could be said he was good for a lesson a day. No matter what he said, you were going to listen - whether you liked it or not. He was considered a "dad" to many and was always ready to take the time to help others solve their problems.

Whenever he greeted someone, he did so like they were family, and always made people feel comfortable and included. Everyone enjoyed his company thanks to his kind heart and charismatic personality. He was determined, strong-willed, and sometimes a little stubborn. His family has fond memories of him pressing his "No Button." Rich also enjoyed sports, especially following his beloved Buffalo Bills.

He was a member of St. Louis Gonzaga Church.

Richard is survived by his devoted wife, Maryellen; his children and their spouses, Anthony J. and Melissa Hobaica, and Danae and Joseph R. LaMarca; grandchildren, Niko Hobaica; Aria LaMarca, Eliana LaMarca, and Charles LaMarca; siblings and their spouses, JoAnn and Christopher Clark, Rosalie and Jack Inman, the late Marie Herman and her husband Frank Herman, and Michael and Marlene Hobaica; many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, and their families; sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Florie and Al Damiano; and many cherished friends. He was

additionally predeceased by his father-in-law and mother-in-law, Anthony F. and Angela T. (Pettinato) Tomaino.
